HOME BASED EARLY HEAD START PROGRAM

Here at HOPES EHS (Early Head Start) Plainfield, we not only serve our children and families in the center, but we also serve them at home. We have two Home Visitors Ms. Abigail Roman and Ms. Flor Alvarenga who currently serve twelve families each. Our Home Based families receive a weekly 1½ hour visit; in which the home visitors teach the children different skills such as Gross Motor, Fine Motor, Communication and more. Not only do the children learn, but the parents learn as well.

The Home Visitors provide the families with different techniques that they could do at home using materials and items that are found in their home. Along with a curriculum based education. our Home Based families receive the same benefits as the center based families. They get help with filling out applications for WIC, insurance and receive referrals in areas where needed. These parents also attend center events such as picture day, end of year activities, workshops on health, safety, and nutrition, parent meetings, and much more. Lastly, twice a month all the Home Based families and children get together for "Socialization", which is where the parents, teachers, and Home Visitors do group activities/workshops together and get to know the other parents and children as well.

TAX SAVINGS!!!

HOPES Community Action Partnership, Inc. is proud to provide Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program to the community for over 10 years. Each year there is an elevated influx of VITA certified tax preparers. They have assisted with 1010 returns and counting. Taxpayers have received over \$1,060,000 in refunds, with over \$350,000 of it being EITC (Earned Income Tax Credit). All tax preparation and filing is done free of charge.
